Proximal	Nearest the midline or beginning of a structure	Distal	Farthest from the midline or farthest from the beginning of a structure
Superficial (external)	Near the surface	Deep (internal)	Away from the surface
Palmar	Caudal surface of the front paw (manus)	Plantar	Caudal surface of the rear paw (pes)
